In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. NO DOGS are allowed in many of these motels. Motels marked * are listed as “pet friendly”, but it is your responsibility to confirm this with the motel at the time you make your reservation.

This trial is licensed by the AKC and recognized by the American Field and Amateur Field Trial Clubs of America. Your dog does not have to be registered in the Field Dog Stud Book to compete, but only dogs with FDSB registrations will be recognized as qualifying at this trial to run in American Field championships.

Parking and stake-outs are permitted in the main campground area and the area immediately north of the big pines. ABSOLUTELY NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED AND NO HORSES STAKED OUT ON CRP GROUND.

Unauthorized vehicles are not allowed anywhere on the course (including the breakaway areas). Failure to follow these guidelines could result in immediate loss of these grounds for any future field event. Parking is permitted on the concrete slab, but please leave room for others to get in and out.

CAMPING: Primitive camping on the grounds. Electrical hookups are available at Thayer Lake Park, approximately 1-1/2 miles northwest of the grounds.

DIRECTIONS TO THE GROUNDS

The field trial grounds are located south of U.S. Hwy 34 at Thayer, Iowa, approximately midway between Creston and Osceola.

From Thayer, go two miles south on Union County Rd. P-64, then one and one-quarter mile west on a gravel road.
